Conference Theme

**Deepening our Understanding: Building a Stronger
Community for Justice in Education**

Priority will be given to proposals that address the conference theme. All presentations will be one-hour in duration. Consider topics related to:

- Exploration of our own bias and exposing own prejudices
- Understanding language and culture and its implications for teaching
- Presenting resources and activities for Teaching Black Lives Matter
- Sharing inclusion strategies for equity in the classroom
- Education for justice in early childhood and P-12 settings
- Strategies teachers use to equalize remote learning
- Intersections between language, culture, and special education
- Increasing diverse candidate teacher pipeline and retention
- Social emotional learning and building strong student communities
- Creative practices to prepare preservice teachers for diversity in the classroom

- Title of session
- Session proposal (200-300 words)
- Session abstract for the conference program (50 words)
- Presentation preference (Friday, Saturday or Both Days)
- Presentation keywords
